

A reminder: Study guides are available at www.wnyreferee.org (At the "Referee" tab). It would be beneficial to review those before taking the recert test.

Recertification testing is intended as a teaching tool. You are welcome - in fact, encouraged - to refer to resources like the Laws of the Game and Advice to Referees. We want you to know the answers, and if looking up the answer will help you, please do!

Test questions and their order are randomly generated for each test session, so the odds of two tests being the same are almost zero.

The testing process is not complete until you click on the button to finalize your session after answering all the questions. At any time prior to that, you can return to questions and change your answers. You can skip a question and come back later. The column on the left side of the window shows you which questions you have completed. Click on the question number to return to a question.

You may also log out and return as many times as you wish, and you will be able to pick up where you left off.

Once you finalize your test, you will be given your score. You will be able to see which questions you missed in the column on the left. A green letter next to the slide (question) number means that you selected that answer and it was correct. Two red letters next to the slide number shows the answer you selected and the answer that was correct. If you click on the slide number, it will display the question and indicate the correct answer. If you received a passing score, your written testing requirement has been met. If you do not receive a passing score, you will have to retake the test.
