

About Identities

“Identities” can get a little confusing for new users. The good news is, most of you are not affected. If you only have one registration class (Referee, for example), Identities are not an issue. But if you hold multiple registrations (Referee, Assignor, Assessor, Instructor), each registration class will be a separate Identity.

Identities become important when you want to perform certain functions in Game Officials. Most course registrations are open only to specific classes of registrants. For example, if you are logged in as an Instructor, you won’t be able to register for an Advanced Referee class. If you are logged in as a Referee, you won’t be able to register for your Assignor recertification clinic.

Although this takes some “getting used to”, it is easily fixed. On any screen in Game Officials, you will have the option to “Change Identity.” There are two links for this service. One is in the black menu bar at the top of the screen, and the other is near the bottom of the column on the left side of the screen.

Click on either of the “Change Identity” links, and a listing of your current Identities will appear. “Current” will appear in the left hand column for your current status. If you need to change to a different Identity, click on “Switch” in the left hand column next to the identity you wish to change to.
